Meals on Wheels: The MOW service is free to qualified residents. It is funded 100% through donations and grants. On average the Meals on Wheels program provides 3,000-3,500 meals annually.

Cancer Screening Fund: Local residents can use this fund for their mammogram care. Uninsured or low income community members qualify for the program. We recommend visiting with your primary care provider.
